07th March 1969 is considered as a red-letter day in the history of the Archdiocese of Goa; for it was on this day that the foundation of the Diocesan Catechetical Centre (DCC) had been laid to spread the message of Christ and His teachings in the Archdiocese of Goa.

Diocesan Catechetical Centre was earlier known as Secretariat for Christian Doctrine. Its name was later changed by Msgr. Francisco da Piedade Rebello, Apostolic Administrator to the DIOCESAN CATECHETICAL CENTER (DCC). Its headquarters were at the Pastoral Institute, St. Pius X, Old Goa. On 08th April 1969, its first Committee included Fr. Lucio da Viega Coutinho (Director of Pastoral Institute), Fr. Blaise Lobo O.F.M. and Fr. Almir de Souza. The latter served the Centre as its Director till 1989.

Fr. Almir de Souza. We were blessed to have him celebrate the Holy Mass. Fr. Romeu Godinho, Director of the Diocesan Catechetical Centre, gave a formal address about the Golden Jubilee celebration of the Diocesan Catechetical Centre. His report was filled with gratitude to all the past directors of the Centre. The Church Choir of St. Francis Xavier's Church, Pirna helped in making the Eucharistic Celebration more meaningful with their beautiful voices in harmony.

After the Mass all the lay faithful representing their parishes and schools along with the priests present, were escorted to the Pastoral Institute, Old Goa by a very lively brass band. At the Pastoral Institute a prayer service was conducted by Ms. Fausta Gonsalves and Sr. Pelina Vaz, followed by the blessing of the renovated office of the DCC by Rev. Fr.
